An Act for preventing any Double Guinea, Guinea, Half Guinea, or Seven Shilling Piece, from being received at a larger Value respectively than Fortytwo Shillings, Twenty-one Shillings, Ten Shillings and Sixpence, or Seven Shillings, respectively; and also for preventing any Bank Note from being received for any smaller Sum than the Sum therein specified.

E it enacted by the King's most Excellent Majesty, by and with the Advice and Consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, and Commons, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the Authority of the same. That, from and after the passing of this Act, no Person shall receive for any Double Guinea, Single Guinea, Half Guinea, or Seven Shilling Piece respectively, any larger Sum than Forty-two Shillings, Twenty-one Shillings, Ten Shillings and Sixpence, or Seven Shillings, respectively, and that no Person shall receive for any Note of the Governor and Company of the Bank of England, any smaller Sum than the Sum therein-mentioned to be payable to the Bearer on Demand.
