The COMMITTEE who were appointed to confider of giving Powers to the Justices of the Peace for the more effectually repairing County Bridges, and to report the fame, together with their Opinion thereupon, to the House;—and to whom the Report, which upon the Thirtieth Day of May, One thousand Eight hundred, was made from the Committee who were appointed to confider of giving Power to the Justices of the Peace for the more effectually repairing County Bridges, and to report the fame, together with their Opinion thereupon, to the House, and who were in-ftructed to consider of the Steps proper to be taken previous to the building of Bridges that are to be deemed County Bridges, and also of empowering Justices of the Peace, in their Quarter Sessions, to alter the Situation of County Bridges, and to widen and enlarge the fame, and the Roads at the Ends thereof, and who were likewise instructed to consider of empowering Justices to direct Actions to be brought, in the Name of the Clerk of the Peace, for Damages done to County Bridges, County Gaols, Bridewells, and other County Works, was referred;—and who were instructed to consider of the several other Matters referred to in the faid Report;-

Refolved,

THAT it is the Opinion of this Committee, That the Powers given by the different Statutes now in Force, relative to the Repair of County Bridges, are in some Respects defective.

Refolved,

THAT it is the Opinion of this Committee, That the Surveyors of County Bridges, appointed by Justices of the Peace at their General Quarter Seffions, should have the fame Power to get, take, and carry away, Stones, Gravel, Sand, and other Materials for the Repair of Roads over Bridges, and the Roads for the Space of Three Hundred Feet at each of the Ends thereof, as are given to the Surveyors of Highways by virtue of an A& paffed in the Thirteenth Year of the Reign of His present Majesty, making Satisfaction for the Damages done thereby, in the fame Manner as is directed by the faid Act.

Resolved,

THAT it is the Opinion of this Committee, That the Justices of Peace in General Quarter Schions, should be empowered to alter the Situation of County Bridges, and to widen and enlarge the fame, and the Roads for the Space or Three Hundred Feet at each of the Ends thereof, and to order their Surveyor to agree for the Recompence to be made for the Ground to be taken for those Purposes; and if the faid Surveyor cannot agree with the Perfons, Bodies Politic or Corporate, who are feifed and possessed of such Ground, or if they cannot be found, or shall refuse to treat or take such Recompence as shall be offered to them respectively by such Surveyor, then the faid Justices shall have Power to impannel a Jury at the Quarter Sessions, to assess the Damages to be given and the Recompence to be made to the Owners and others interested in the faid Grounds, in the Manner directed by the faid Act of the Thirteenth Year of the Reign of His present Majesty, in respect to the Widening of Highways; and

if the Jury shall give a Verdict for more Money than was offered by the faid Surveyor, the Costs of the Proceedings to be paid by the faid Surveyor; but if the Jury shall give a Verdict for no more or for less than was offered by the Surveyor, then the Costs to be paid by the Person or Body Corporate who refused to accept the Satisfaction so offered to him; and that on Payment or Tender of the Money fo to be awarded, on leaving it in the Hands of the Clerk of the Peace, if the Party entitled to receive it cannot be found or shall refuse to accept it, the Interest of such Person shall be divested out of him; faving nevertheless to the Owner of the Ground all Mines and Minerals which may be got without breaking the Ground, and all Timber and Wood growing on fuch Ground.

Refolved.

THAT it is the Opinion of this Committee, That the Powers and Provisions of the faid Statute of the Thirtcenth Year of the Reign of His prefent Majesty, relative to Highways, and the Surveyors of Highways in general, be extended to County Bridges and Roads at the Ends thereof, and the Surveyors of fuch Bridges and Roads, as far as the same can be extended and applied.

THAT it is the Opinion of this Committee, That the Inhabitants of Counties should have Power of suing and being fued, in the Name of their Surveyor or some other Public

Refolved,

THAT it is the Opinion of this Committee, That Counties should not be bound to maintain and repair any Bridge hereafter to be built, unless the Magistrates in General Quarter Seffions affembled, should determine that such Bridge is necesfary to be built for the Purposes of the Public, and should confent thereto.
