SECOND REPORT.

THE COMMITTEE appointed to take into Consideration the Standing Orders of this House, relative to BILLS of INCLOSURE, and to report the same, with their Opinion thereupon, and who were empowered to Report, from Time to Time, to the House;—

HAVE, further considered the Matters to them referred, and have come to the following Resolution; viz.

Resolved,

THAT it is the Opinion of this Committee, That Bills for the Purpose of inclosing small Tracts of Land, not exceeding Three Hundred Acres, and effecting the same by Clauses usual in such Bills, shall be considered, as to the Payment of Fees, only as single Bills; and that those for the Inclosure of small Tracts of Land, to be effected as above, not exceeding One Hundred Acres, shall be subject only to the Payment of Half the Bill Fees due on a single Bill: The Admeasurement in both Cases to be proved according to such Form as may be prescribed by any Act passed in this Session of Parliament.
